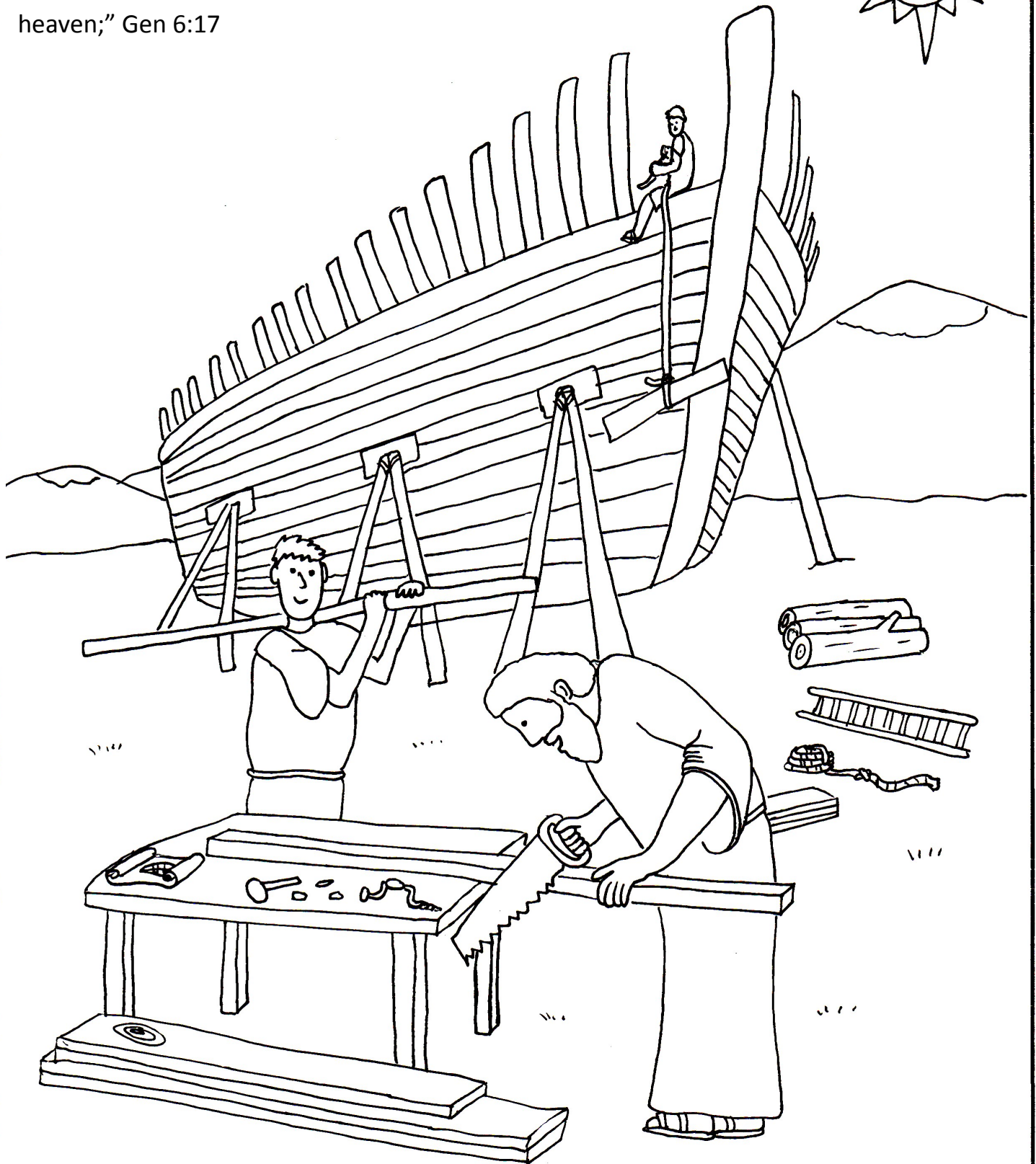


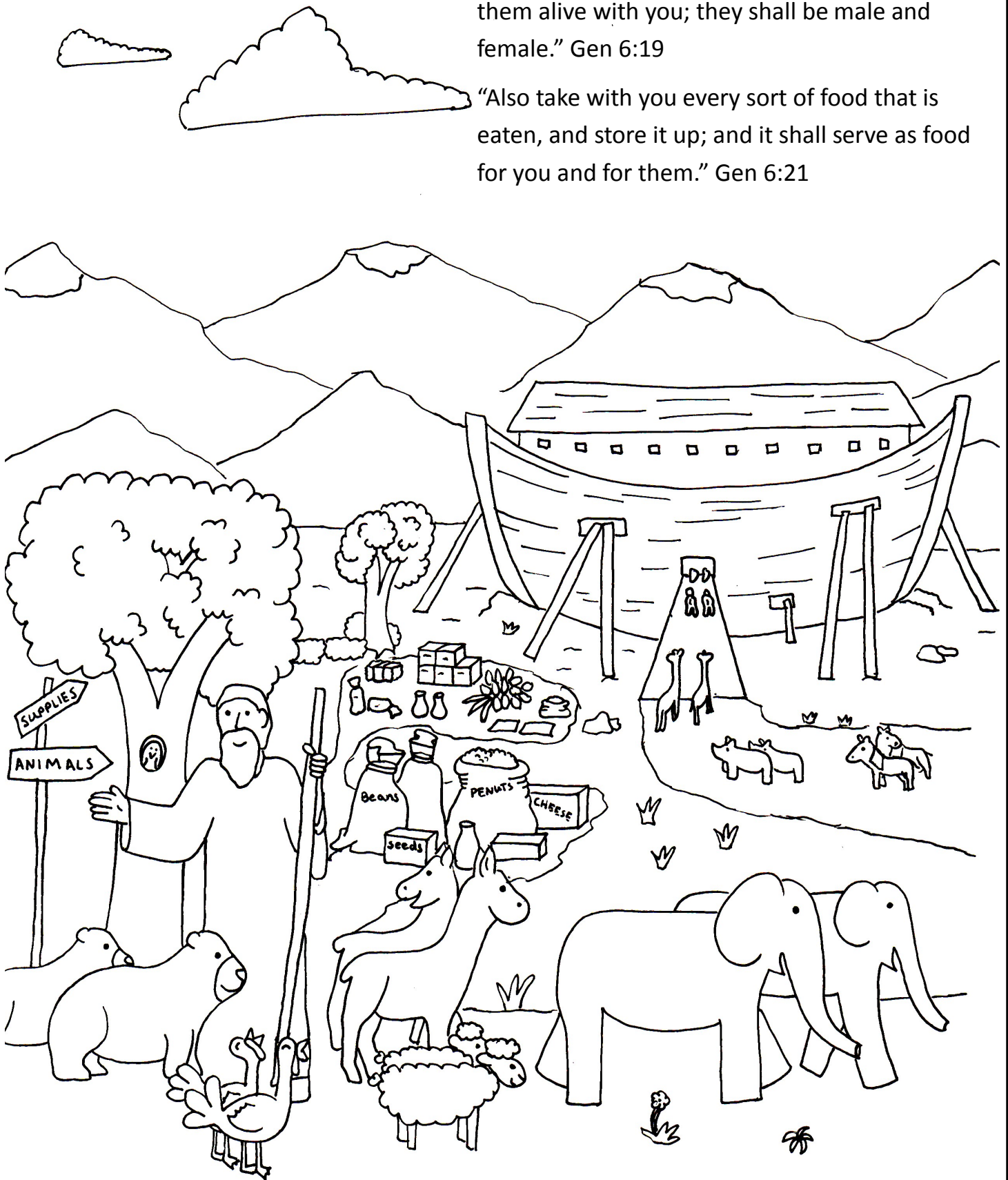

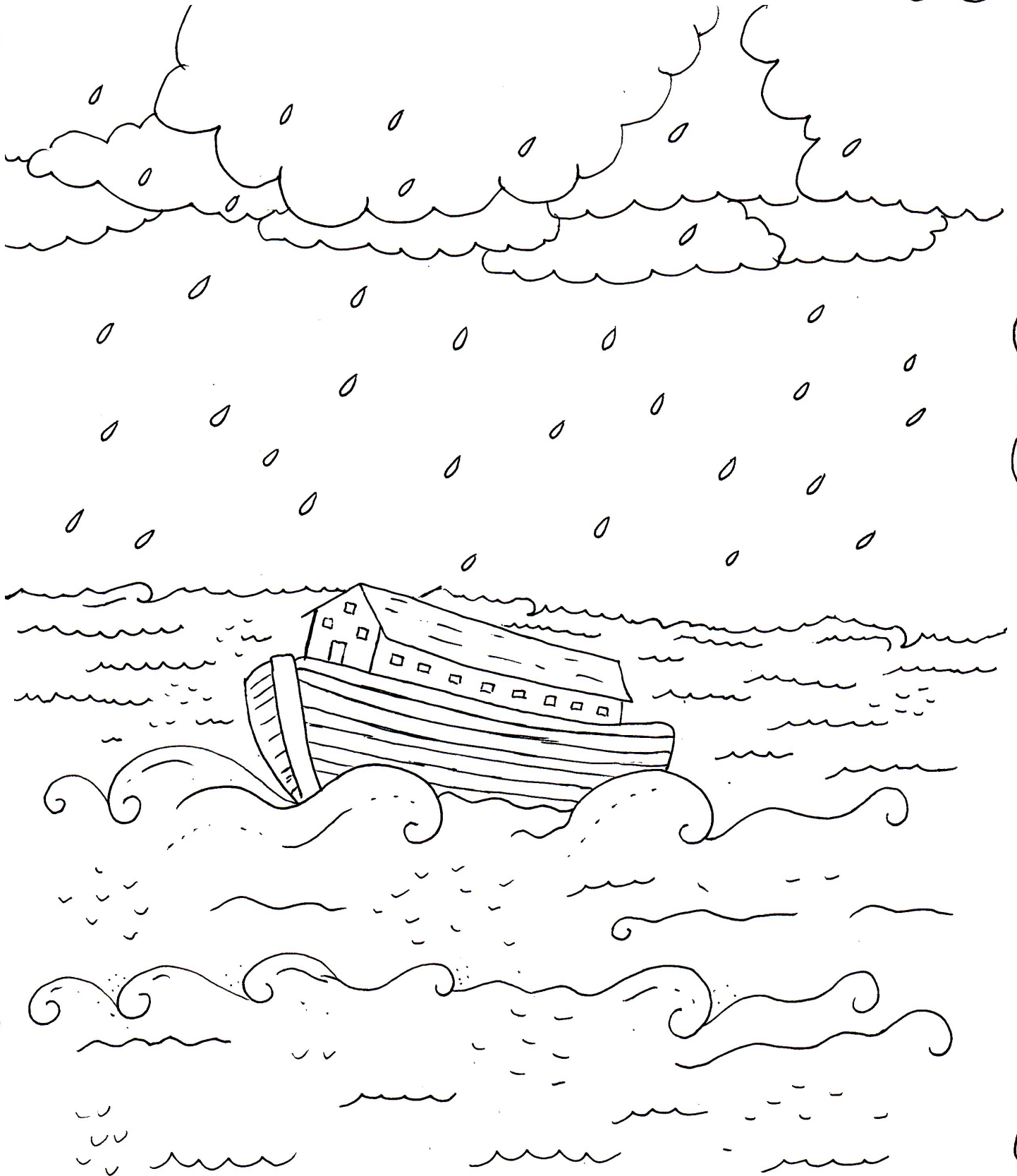
“For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life from under heaven;” Gen 6:17



“And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ark, to keep them alive with you; they shall be male and female.” Gen 6:19

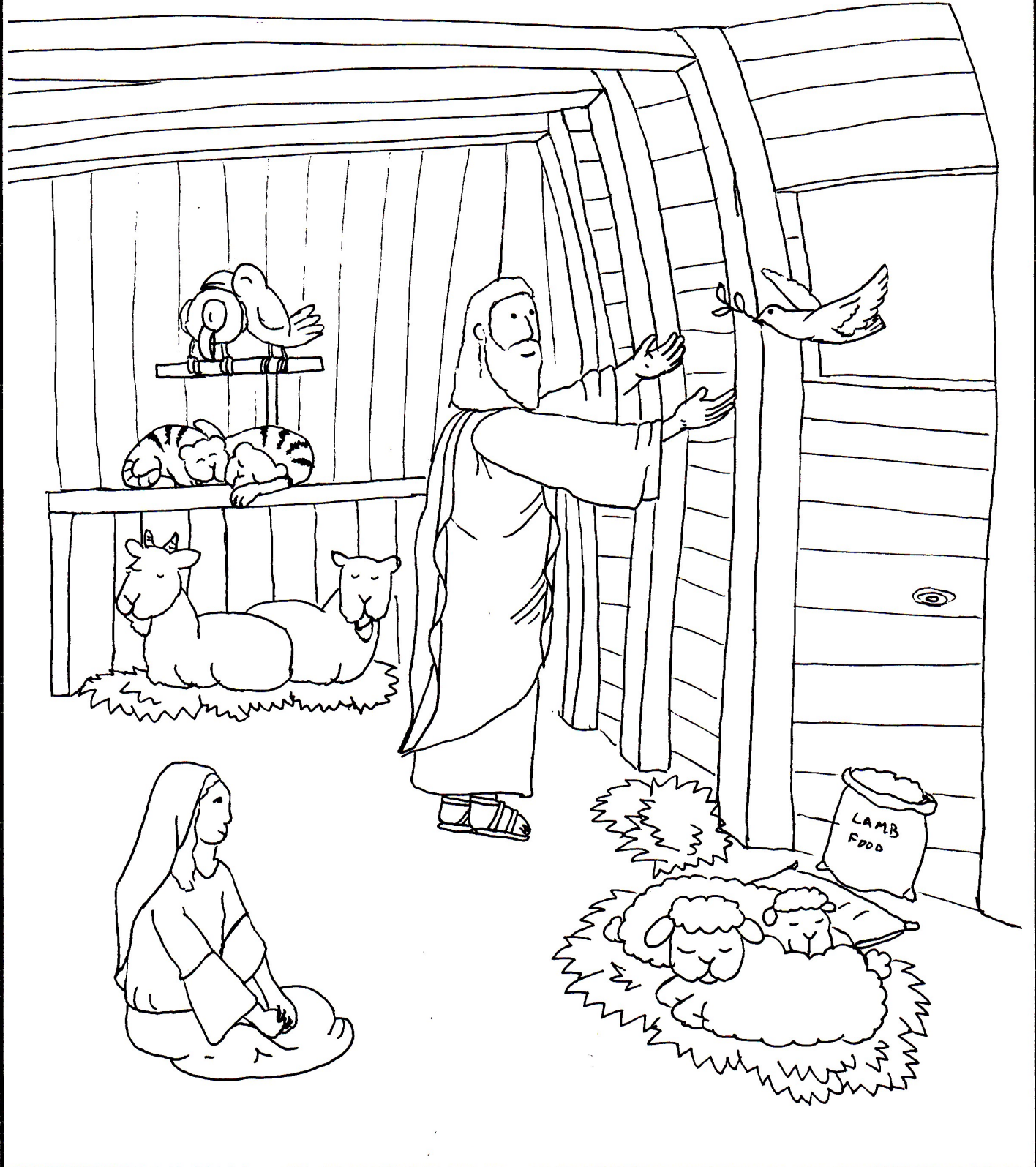
“Also take with you every sort of food that is eaten, and store it up; and it shall serve as food for you and for them.” Gen 6:21
