

Assembly Instructions:

Either cut out around Pope Francis including the dotted line boxes at the bottom, or cut out around the large rectangle containing Pope Francis. Fold your Pope Francis paper doll at the solid black line on top of their head, and the two at his feet. Tuck one tab under the other and secure with tape, glue or glue dots.





Assembling your Pop - out Saint Scenes

You will need the following supplies:

- Printed scenes (I recommend printing on cardstock)
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils/crayons/markers if you wish to color your own scenes
- Tape, glue stick or glue dots
- A flat surface to work on

Assembly Instructions:

Cut your paper in half on the black line (scene background is on the top half and the scene bottom is on the bottom half)



Fold the scene background in half (like a greeting card)

Cut out the bottom of the scene on the black lines.

Fold the bottom of the scene in half, matching up the two straight edges of the wedge (with the printed picture on the outside- see picture)

Fold the two tabs up.

Insert the bottom of the scene into the folded scene background 'card' and secure the tabs to the outside glue/glue dots or tape.

Give it a good creasing, allow to dry (if needed) and then open for fun!
