# Instructions and Recommendations

## Supplies needed:

File Folder

Cardstock for printing on

Stapler

Glue stick or glue dots or tape

Crayons/color pencils for coloring B&W copies

## Printing:

I recommend printing on cardstock for durability. When using Adobe to print, be sure to click 'actual' under printing options.

Print the color versions for an already finished project. Or print the black and white version for your children to color in themselves.

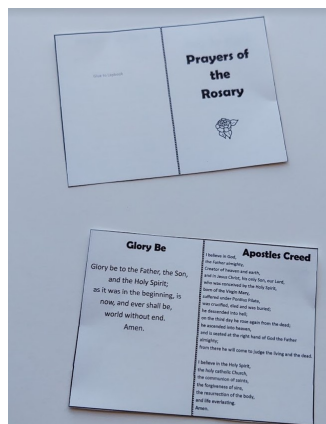
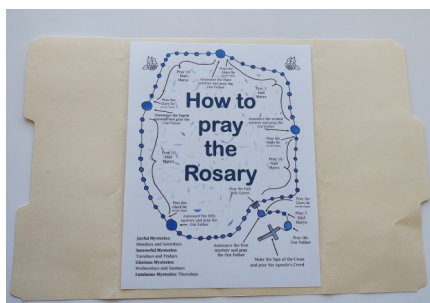
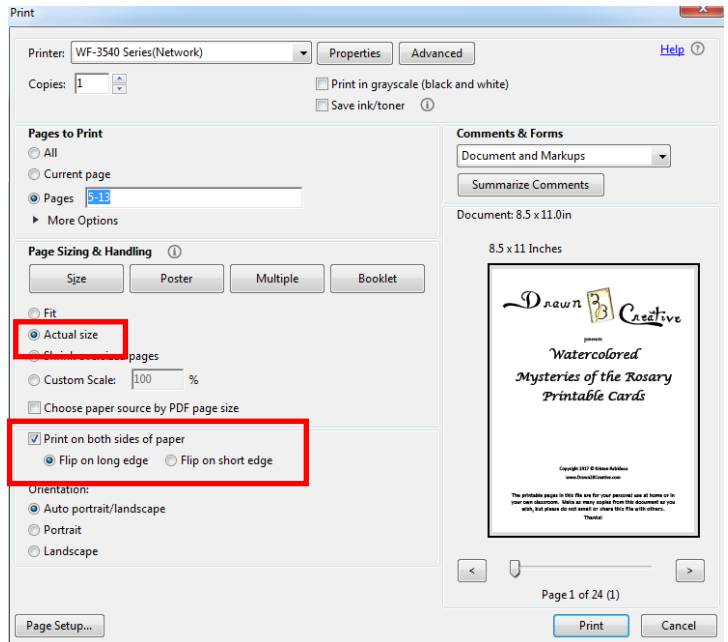
For the Prayer booklet (pgs 6-7, or 13-14), print **two sided flipping on the long edge**.

## Assembly:

Open your file folder, and then fold the sides inward to meet in the middle.

Print the "How to pray the Rosary page," color if desired, glue into the main middle section of your lapbook.

Print the prayer booklets pages, 2 sided (see printing instructions and picture above), cut out around each double page section, stack, staple in the middle, and fold in half. Glue onto one of the sides of the lapbook.



Print each of the Mysteries of the Rosary fold-outs.

There are two different ways to use the Mysteries of the Rosary fold outs.

1) Accordion style: You can either cut out along the black line (easier for younger children) or cut out going over the arches, but keeping connected in between the mysteries. Fold accordion style (back and forth) and glue or glue-dot the back of the last mystery onto one of the sides of the lapbook.

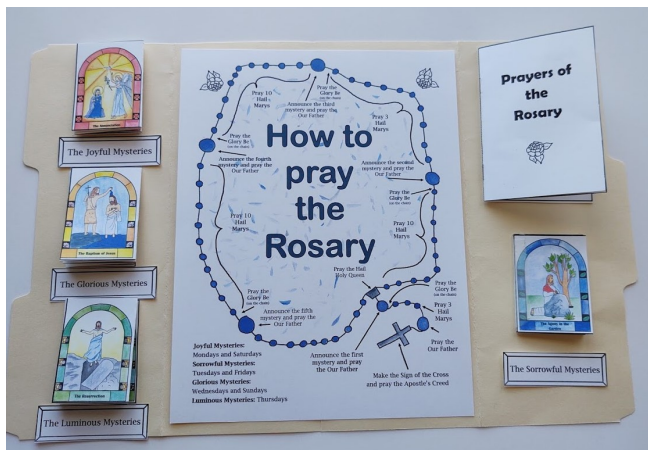
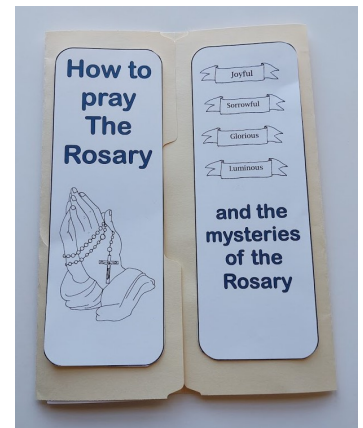


2) Mini-booklets: Cut out around each individual mystery. Use a piece of tape to tape the left side of the 1st mystery to the left side of the 2nd mystery. Run a piece of tape down the left side of the 1st mystery again, and attach to the back of the 3rd mystery. Keep doing this until you have taped all 5 mysteries into a little booklet with tape as the 'binding.'



Print, cut out and add the labels for each set of Mysteries.

Print, cut out and add the covers to the lapbook, on the outside of the flaps.



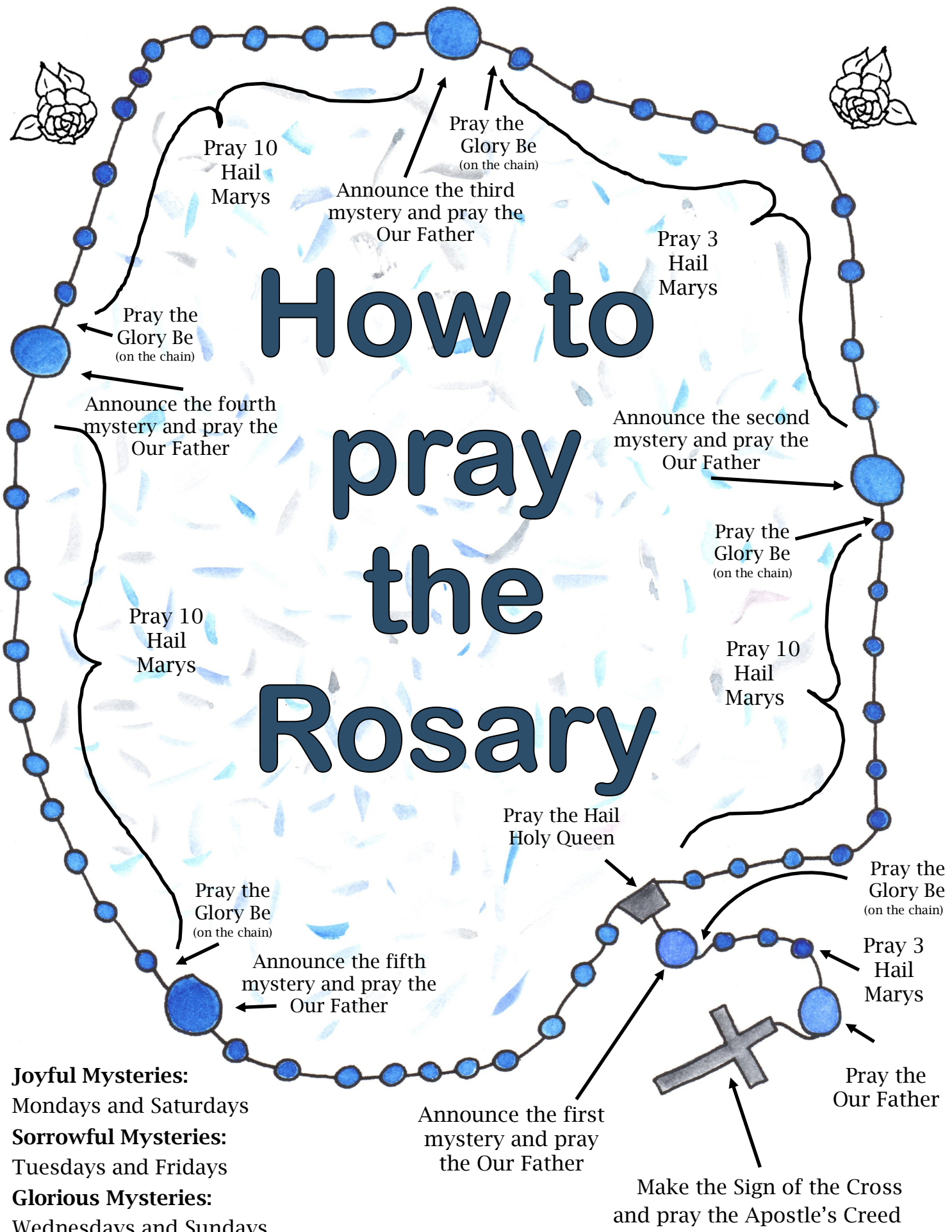
Praying the Rosary with Children:

Adapt your prayer time to accommodate the ages and abilities of your children. Not many young children can sit through all 5 decades of a rosary, so consider doing just one decade a day. Or if you wish to cover all 5 mysteries, you can shorten your rosary to just saying 3 Hail Mary's for each decade instead of all 10.

The important thing to remember is ANY time praying is better than NO time praying. Even if it's distracted, noisy, or chaotic at times, you are still setting the example of a relationship with Jesus through the Our Lady when you pray the Rosary with (or in front of) your children.

I'll be praying that this Mysteries of the Rosary Lapbook allows your children to visualize the life, death, resurrection and miracles of Jesus and Our Blessed Mother, on which we meditate using the Rosary.
